Day 1 Amman, Jordan

Welcome to Jordan! Transfer to your hotel. Day is at leisure. Enjoy the WELCOME DINNER with your traveling companions.

Day 2 Amman-Wadi Mujib-Petra

Travel to Mount Nebo where Moses saw the Promised Land. At Madaba, visit ST. GEORGE"S CHURCH, which houses a 6th-century mosaic map of the Holy Land. Explore MADABA ARCHAEOLOGICAL MUSEUM. Visit Mukawir, where Salome danced and John the Baptist was imprisoned and beheaded. Afterwards, view Wadi Mujib, the "Jordanian Grand Canyon." Visit Kerak and the CRUSADER CASTLE. This evening experience a candle-lit "Petra by Night" tour.

Day 3 Petra

Day of exploration in the "rose-red city" of PETRA. Lost to the world for centuries, it is located in the biblical land of Moab. Walk down the Siq, the narrow gorge made famous in the movie *Indiana Jones and the Last Crusade*. Stand in awe in front of the iconic and famed Treasury. In addition to seeing spectacular temples and tombs, sip tea in a Bedouin tent.

Day 4 Petra-Wadi Rum-Amman

Depart Petra for a jeep tour in Wadi Rum, home to stunning desert beauty and the place where Lawrence of Arabia was filmed. Return to Amman for guided city sightseeing, including the Citadel, ARCHAEOLOGICAL MUSEUM, downtown, and much more

Day 5 Amman-Jerash-Um Qais-Dead Sea

Today travel north to OLD JERASH, the best-preserved Greco-Roman city in the Middle East. Also, visit Ajloun and its "Hilltop Castle." While en route, stop at the Jabbok River where Jacob wrestled with the Angel, and Um Qais, sire of the Gadarene swine miracle. Afterwards, journey to the Dead Sea, the lowest point on Earth.

Day 6 Dead Sea. Excursion to Bethany Beyond-the-Jordan
